Current political and economic situation in Sri Lanka.

1. Sri Lanka's budget deficit had ballooned to [1016 billion LKR](#) (about \$5.03 billion) after the civil war ended. (2020) saw the budget deficit more than double to [2090 billion LKR](#) (about \$10.34 billion).
2. Sri Lanka was already in financial trouble before the Covid-19 pandemic emerged worldwide and impacted its economy
3. A ban on chemical fertilizers is not bad in terms of practices, but the government did not provide training or tools to farmers or give farmers the necessary time to transition to organic farming. As a result, the paddy (rice) cultivation alone dropped by 40% according to a government report.

Current political and economic situation in Sri Lanka.

4. Due to the pandemic many Sri Lankans who work as migrant workers in the Middle East were sent home during the pandemic which had a large impact on the Sri Lankan economy. Also tourism industry of Sri Lanka decline.

5. Another reason for financial crisis was, the Government of Sri Lanka attempted to control the USD/LKR exchange ratio artificially which further worsened the financial situation.

6. One of the main aims of boosting the economy was attracting investors with tax holidays, creating special economic zones etc ,but the Government did not get expected amount of investors.

7. The destruction of natural forests and mangrove forests have led to a reduction in rainfall, which leads to reduction in harvest in the Agricultural sector and it has a negative impact to the power supply in the Country.

Background to the current crisis or contemporary situation

1. Sri Lanka is experiencing one of the worst economic crisis in decades and the dwindling foreign reserves is also felt on the electricity consumption, fuel consumption and cooking gas resulting in severe shortages.
2. Nearly, 1000 bakeries have been shut as a response to shortages of cooking gas triggered by chaotic foreign reserve crisis.
3. The surge in global oil prices further aggravated the fuel shortage in Sri Lanka as the country had to pay more than before to get the supply of fuel with the risk of more outflow of foreign reserves was on the cards.
4. The 30 year civil war that ended in 2019 and the current Pandemic situation has made a great impact on the current economic situation.

Domestic challenges faced by NAFSO/HDO

1. Lack of financial ability to assist more members.
2. The harvest and crops are being destroyed by wild animals such as elephants , wild boars.
3. The shortage of fertilizer and pesticide for the crops.
4. Most areas are experiencing a shortage in rainfall and due to that Agriculture development is hindered.
5. Due to the economic inflation rate of Sri Lanka marketing and distribution issues have risen.

How NAFSO is trying to intervene to agricultural production

1. Promote self sufficient small Scale food producer units in order to face the challenges of food soaring prices.
2. Strengthening the rural economy by increasing agricultural production in rural areas and address food scarcity especially in Rural areas of Sri Lanka.
3. Intervening in rising nutritional problems and address rural poverty through promoting income generation by promoting agri productions.
4. Removal of harmful plants such as salvinia from rural water bodies and use of these plants for fertilizer production and thereby improve the freshwater fisheries industry.
5. Strengthen women and youth participation in the Agri sector, by providing them knowledge to so.

Activities



Contribution made by NAFSO to address it in past & present

Polonnaruwa, Miridiya Organization.

1. Organic Fertilizer Production using Salvinia, Japan Jabara and other weeds covered the water bodies which disturb the inland fishing industry.
2. Promote and expand home gardening with the help of member families.
3. Strengthen Self Sufficient Small Scale Food Producer Units.
4. Implemented a nursery of plants in order to distribute for agriculture activities.
